KINGSTON/FORTY FORT LITTLE LEAGUE POLICY ON VANDALISM OF LEAGUE PROPERTY

KFF Little League has a zero tolerance policy regarding vandalism at any level against any league property at any of the fields maintained by the league.

Vandalism is defined as willful or malicious destruction or defacement of public or private property.

Locations include the following locations:

- Hamilton Park, including Janjigan, Memorial, Softball fields
- Tripp St, including Holy Name fields
- O'Hara field

It further includes any vandalism at fields that players visit as part of their team when traveling outside the Kingston/Forty Fort league.

This includes all scoreboards, dugouts, snack stands, bleachers, sheds, bathroom facilities and any equipment or tools used to maintain the fields.

Any player found committing an act of vandalism on or against any league property will be subject to an immediate one game suspension.

A further act of vandalism will result in disqualification from All Star play as well as a two game suspension.

After two suspensions, the KFF board will vote on player's future eligibility with the league. If the offense warrants, the local police will be notified and restitution will be sought. For questions on this policy, contact the league president, player agent, or fields and property vice-president.
